The discussion, hosted by founder Emanuel Kuntzelman, will delve into the potential for immanent transformation by using the power of the mind to accelerate human evolution. The Magic of the Mind will highlight how, in the 21st century, evolution has brought us full circle. Kuntzelman will touch on how at the earliest stages of human existence, the first humans found self-reflective consciousness and their own state of mind and how, today, humans are now reaching out for a higher level of consciousness, the universal mind of the quantum field. Just as words brought thought to the mind, the total understanding of the potential of our mind gives us a psycho-spiritual framework for transformation. Kuntzelman's goal for *The Magic of the Mind* is to educate and inspire the audience about the power they hold to create social transformation.

Kuntzelman realizes that society creates its own reality and must accept that challenge to evolve beyond cultural conditioning. While doing research, he became intrigued by the diversity of ideas in the many countries he visited. Seeing that people could benefit greatly from a deeper understanding of cultures beyond their own, he created the Center for Cultural Interchange (CCI) and the Foundation for the Future in cooperation with his wife, Laura, the CEO of CCI. These organizations now foster international exchanges and activities for some ten thousand participants annually. *The Magic of the Mind* is the third talk in a series of discussions led by Kuntzelman

In conjunction with his work at CCI and the Foundation in Madrid, Spain, Kuntzelman coordinates the Greenheart initiative worldwide from their Chicago headquarters. Greenheart projects and activities include cultural exchange environmental programs throughout the U.S.; the Greenheart eco-fair trade Shop in Chicago and in Ibiza, Spain; volunteer programs through Greenheart Travel; the study group Ibiza Ecologic and the Casita Verde in Ibiza; a nature inspired Greenheart Music company; and the Greenheart Guide to Ibiza and Formentera.
